

New Approach in Treatment of Expulsive Hemorrhage after Cataract Surgery

Advantages:

To remove blood from the suprachoroidal space in expulsive hemorrhage after cataract surgery.

Methods:

Sclerotomies, high flow infusion pars plana vitrectomy and silicone oil tamponade were combined with a temporary transcleral silicone tube drainage system.

Effectiveness / Safety:

Good anatomic and functional results ($VA \geq 0.2$) in treated 7 cases.
