### **Advantages:**

The "comprehensive" - rather than reflex-based - approach to the management of the injured eye allows to surgeon to carefully plan the operation and aim for the best possible outcome.

### **Methods:**

The surgical strategy involves consideration of not only the intraocular abnormalities already present, but also those complications that have a reasonably high risk of occurring subsequently. The management therefore entails dealing with the latter as well as with the former.

### **Effectiveness / Safety:**

The probability of secondary complications is reduced without introducing additional risks.
