

## **The Role of Vitreomacular Traction in Chronic Refractive Central Serous Choroidopathy**

### **Advantages:**

Vitreotomy may be beneficial in cases with recurrent chronic CSC when partial PVD is documented with the new spectral domain OCT.

### **Methods:**

PPV and PVD with ILM peeling in a case with diffuse chronic central pigment epitheliopathy where vitreous attachments are documented with the spectral OCT.

### **Effectiveness / Safety:**

Vitreous attachments may play a role when PDT treatments are not sufficient to resolve the condition.
