

Densiron: an up-date tamponade for giant retinal tears retinal detachment

In contrast to standard retinal detachment procedure, the management of giant retinal tears introduces a mechanical difficulty in managing the slippage of the retina and the exposure of the retinal pigment epithelium. The injection from bottom to top and the density of the densiron will allow a secure and easy surgery by increasing control during the procedure.
