

Brillant peel staining pro

I have been performing a lot of ILM removals without any dyeing guided only by the membrane reflection provided by the slit lamp illumination. When the dyeing appeared, I did not receive that as a resolution as:

- Membrane blue was dyeing the vitreous fibres as well as the ILM and was therefore obliging me to increase the amount of removed vitreous
- ICG had no official French authorization to be injected.

When the Brilliant Peel appeared, all the critics that I made in the past disappeared. The fastness of its use, the information it provides due to its ILM selectivity allowed me, at the end of the day, to go faster in my procedure. I must admit, after having performed 16000 ILM peelings, that my surgical manipulation, thanks to the brilliant peel is much more secure, precise and a traumatic.
