

## **An unusual large tractional macular break**

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### **Purpose:**

To describe an unusual case of a large tractional macular break.

### **Methods:**

Case report.

### **Results:**

A 38-year-old healthy man presented with a sudden decrease of vision in his left eye. He had no history of ocular trauma. Visual acuity was 20/20 in the right eye and counting fingers in the left eye. Anterior segment examination results were unremarkable in both eyes. Fundus examination showed no abnormality in the right eye and a 2-disc-diameter tractional macular break without associated retinal detachment in the left eye.

### **Conclusion:**

This case illustrates an unusual location and size of a tractional retinal break. Its cause and management remain unclear.

### **Take-home message:**

A sight-threatening large macular break may develop in the absence of ocular trauma.
