

Retinal Incarceration Associated with Open Globe Injuries

SYNOPSIS

A frequent cause for retinal detachment occurring in open globe injuries is retinal incarceration. The boundary between which cases are operable and which are not has been moved forward as new surgical techniques and materials have become available through the years. Aim of this video is to illustrate some of these concepts as we consider a first case in which the boundary of operability has been stretched forward and a second case in which there is a happy ending for a severe injury.
