

Trypan Blue-assisted Vitrectomy: More Condiments in France

SYNOPSIS

We evaluated the efficacy of trypan blue (TB) dye for the staining and removal of the internal limiting membrane (ILM), epiretinal membranes (ERM), and the mechanical detachment of the posterior hyaloid during pars plana vitrectomy. No adverse reaction related to the use of TB was observed immediately postoperatively or 12 months after surgery. Trypan blue staining of the ILM, ERM, and the posterior hyaloid is a useful adjunct in vitreoretinal surgery.
