Diabetic macular edema "Prophylactive" Surgery

Purpose:

We are presenting our ILM removal in diabetic vitrectomies.

Methods:

We divided our patients in two groups: one with persistent edema and the other with patients that have removal of ILM during a vitrectomy for dense hemorrhage, with or without triamcinolone.

Results:

After the removal of hemorrhage if the macula have clinical appearance or significant edema we performed dye-enhanced ILM removal and we are presenting this step as a "prophylactive" macular edema surgery.
